



# Task Force Recommendations Approved by the Board of Education

1. Align SDUSD graduation requirements with UC/CSU "a-g" subject requirements

YES-March 29, 2011

- Add career readiness graduation requirements YES—June 14, 2011
- Increase required graduation credits from 44 to 48 NO—March 29, 2011
- 4. Require new graduation requirements for the Class of 2016 YES—March 29, 2011
- 5. Encourage extra support for students earning "Ds" and "Fs" YES—March 29, 2011



## Task Force Recommendations Approved by the Board of Education (cont.)

- Align SDUSD graduation requirements with UC/ CSU "a-g" subject requirements
  - Changes
    - c. Math: One Year (2 Credits)—Intermediate Algebra 1 2
    - e. World Language: Two Years (4 credits)—same language

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## Task Force Recommendations Approved by the Board of Education (cont.)

- 2. Add career readiness graduation requirements
  - Class of 2016: One Year (2 credits)
  - Class of 2017: Two Years (4 credits)—same pathway

Total 2016 = 1 course (2 semester credits)
Total 2017 = 2 courses (4 semester credits)

- 4. Require new graduation requirements for the Class of 2016
- 5. Encourage extra support for students earning "Ds" and "Fs"


