Please note that summer students may complete either 1 first-time course or 2 credit recovery courses during the 6-week summer session. Each course = 1 semester credit. It is not possible to complete a full-year course (both semesters) during the 6-week summer session.

Each first-time course will require a commitment of at least 3 hours of coursework per day.

Each credit recovery course will require a commitment of at least 2 hours per day.

Students must have an email address and access to a computer with Internet in order to take online courses.

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Information Sheet
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The iHigh Summer Program is funded by the Operation Student Success (OSS) and Operation Student Virtual Learning (OSVL) Dept. of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) grants. Each grant defines the student enrollment criteria. Both grants give priority enrollment to students of active duty military and DoD civilians. Both grants also include provisions for serving a percentage of non-military SDUSD students.

- **Eligibility:** Students entering grades 9-12 in Fall 2012 who live within the San Diego Unified School District boundaries, or who attend SDUSD schools fulltime on an approved interdistrict transfer, are eligible to apply for summer attendance. Students whose parents are active duty military or civilian DoD have priority/assurance of enrollment. **Students must have an email address and access to an Internet-connected computer in order to take online classes.**
- **Courses:** Math courses are open to both military and non-military district students. Non-math courses will be offered based on military/DoD student requests and available staffing. Limited enrollment in non-math courses is available to non-military students.
- **Online application dates:** April 12th-May 31st at www.sandi.net/ihigh (applications will be accepted after May 31st on a space-available basis, with priority to military/DoD students)
- **Confirmations:** Enrollment confirmations will be sent via email by June 15th. Applicants are not enrolled until confirmation is given.
- **iHigh Summer Location:** Serra High School, 5156 Santo Rd., San Diego CA 92124
- **Dates:** June 25 through August 3 (29 days, due to July 4th holiday)
- **Time:** 7:30 AM – 11:50 AM, Monday-Friday (except July 4th)
 - Credit recovery students may complete tutorials and quizzes online (off campus); students must report to campus for proctored unit tests.
 - First-time students may complete tutorials, assignments, quizzes and computer-scored tests online (off campus); students must report to campus for proctored midterm & final exams.
 - Highly-qualified, credentialed teachers are available daily during summer session hours for face-to-face tutoring and assistance.
 - Face-to-face labs would be required for Biology, Chemistry, Physics and/or Earth Science (schedule to be announced if science classes are offered).
 - Students must provide their own transportation to Serra High School.
- **Proposed course list:** Please see separate sheet – Proposed iHigh Summer Course List.
 - Students may take ONE first-time course or TWO credit-recovery courses.
 - Each course earns one semester credit. (not possible to complete a full-year course in only 6 weeks)
 - Students must commit to completing all enrolled courses. (no drops, except for verified emergency)
 - Students who begin a class and then stop working, go on vacation, etc., will end up with a low or failing transcript grade.
 - Special requests will be considered from military/DoD students.
