## **UNIFORM COMPLAINT FORM 1700-02 – Williams Complaint Form**

Education Code (EC) Section 35186 created a procedure for the filing of complaints concerning deficiencies related to instructional materials, conditions of facilities that are not maintained in a clean or safe manner or in good repair, and teacher vacancy or misassignment. The complaint and response are public documents as provided by law. Complaints may be filed anonymously. This does not require two sets of textbooks or instructional materials for each pupil.</li> <li>Textbooks or instructional materials are in poor or unusable condition, have missing pages, or are unreadable due to damage.</li> <li>A pupil was provided photocopied sheets from only a portion of a textbook or instructional materials to address a shortage of textbooks or instructional materials.</li> </ul>
	Facility Conditions (Education Code 35186, 35292.5; 5 CCR 4683)  A condition poses an urgent or emergency threat to the health or safety of students or staff, including: gas leaks, nonfunctioning heating, ventilation, fire sprinklers or airconditioning systems, electrical power failure, major sewer line stoppage, major pest or vermin infestation, broken windows or exterior doors or gates that will not lock and that pose a security risk, abatement of hazardous materials previously undiscovered that pose an immediate threat to pupils or staff, structural damage creating a hazardous or uninhabitable condition, and any other emergency conditions the school district determines appropriate.
