

## LEVELS OF SERVICE (LOS) FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION-FUNDED TRANSPORTATION

Level of Service	Explanation of Service
"9" (Curbside)	The student with this LOS " <u>must be met"</u> at the bus stop by the adult indicated on the F-12 Form or School Emergency Card. This accommodation is only for students with an extreme need which is clearly documented in their most recent LOCKED IEP. If it is determined that the student's needs have changed and curbside is no longer required (per the LOCKED IEP), the Special Education Transportation Liaison in the Transportation Services Department must be notified immediately. Fax a new F-12 to 619-725-7246.
"2"	This student has significant physical/health issues and is eligible for a bus stop of up to two-tenths of a mile (3 blocks). LOS 9 is also an option for these students.
"3"	This LOS is typically for elementary students only. Special Education bus transportation is supplied if the student is not attending the school of residence and has been assigned by the district to another elementary school for specialized services. Students may walk up to four-tenths of a mile or 6 blocks. LOS 9 is also an option for these students.
"4"	This LOS is for secondary students who do not use a wheelchair and live within school boundaries. Secondary students include those who are in middle school and high school, including 6 <sup>th</sup> grade students who attend middle schools. Students at this level may be assigned a school bus stop up to one mile from their residence or service address. LOS 9 is also an option for these students.
