

# STATE ASSESSMENTS

Selecting the appropriate assessment and supports (if applicable) is a requirement for all students within the testing range. 20 USC 1412 (a) (16) (A), 1414 (d) (1) (A) (VI) (aa)

## SBAC-

*Student Participation:* All students at the designated grade levels are required to participate.

*Content and Format:* The content is based on CCSS.

## CAA-

*Student Participation:* Students with the most **significant cognitive disabilities** who are unable to take the SBAC even with accessibility supports and whose individualized education program (IEP) indicates assessment with an alternate test.

*Content and Format:* The content of the alternate assessment is based on **alternate achievement standards** derived from the CCSS for students with the **most significant cognitive disabilities**.

1. The IEP Team selects the appropriate assessment for the student. ELA, Math and Science must all be for the same **test**. Students can take either the **SBA** OR the **CAA**. **Subjects** (ELA, Math, Science) cannot be mixed but must all be from the same **test** type.
2. Select the supports (Universal Tools, Designated Supports, Accommodations) if applicable, that are available for the **test** (SBA or CAA) selected.
