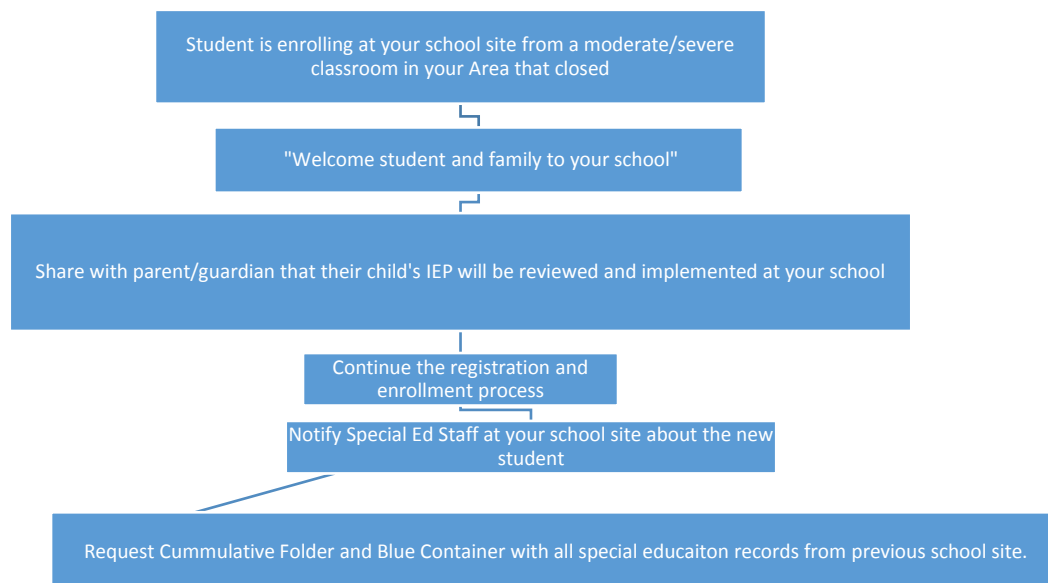


Helpful Hints for Enrolling Students in the Neighborhood Moderate/Severe Cluster Classes



Here are a few talking points for your reference:

- Moderate/Severe Classes are being combined into Neighborhood Cluster Classes.
- Services to students will not change, just the location of services.
- The clustering of classes ensures that students have access to quality instruction, at their level, in a class size that is appropriate.
- Students who have been placed by the Special Education Division receive special education transportation. Transportation will be arranged by the sending case manager or by central office personnel.
- If parents inquire about sibling enrollment, please connect them to the Neighborhood School Enrollment Options Office, as this office is working closely with families to facilitate enrollment based on space availability.

If families have questions regarding the Moderate/Severe Cluster Model, please connect them with a site moderate/severe teacher. If teacher is unavailable, let the parent(s) know he/she will follow up with them within 24 hours.
